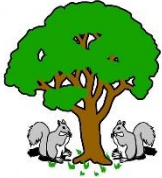

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following the recent inspection of Barton Seagrave Primary School, we are now able to share with you the final report (attached to this letter) which found that our school continues to be a good school.

The two day inspection included observing lessons, talking to children, staff, parents and governors, as well as looking at children's books, leadership documentation, parent survey and other documents/reports prepared by the school.

The report reflects what we as a Governing Body know already about the school and that of the leadership of Mr Krzanicki and Mrs Powell. We were all thrilled with the inspector's verbal feedback to leaders, Governors and the Local Authority being so positive.

We are particularly proud to hear how impressed the inspection team were with our children, their behaviour and the respectful way that they interacted with each other and the adults at school. During the feedback our inspector commented on the fact that children were on task and well behaved not only in their classrooms but also on our playground, in the school halls and when moving around the school. This is a credit not only to our amazing children but also such a positive reflection of our ethos and culture created by leaders, teachers and all the adults that the children encounter during their school day. The inspector highlighted how our vision 'to educate children to confidently face the future' permeates all aspects of school life.

The inspection recognised the lengths that the school has taken to prioritise phonics and early reading and that reading is a high profile area across the school. Our Reading Champions drive, determination and passion that they showed in spreading the joy of reading across our school was also noted and we are very proud of them and their work. Parents in YR, Y1 and Y2 will already be aware of the changes we are making to our early reading book scheme and the inspection report recognises that this is still an area for development.

We are enormously proud of our school and its rich, well-designed curriculum and enrichment opportunities. We continue to be grateful to our dedicated and committed staff, our fantastic children and their supportive parents that make up the fantastic community of Barton Seagrave Primary School.

The school is constantly reviewing the way in which middle leaders check on the impact of their actions and we can confidently say that there are already plans in place that have been actioned to address this additional point for improvement. Leaders across the school are incredibly focussed on making sure that we continue to give our children the best education possible.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank Mr Krzanicki and the wonderful team of staff for their hard work and dedication to Barton Seagrave Primary School.
