## Our ethos

We provide a listening ear and support for children's social and emotional development, and we work in partnership with parents and the school to care for your child.



## The booking process

To secure your child's place at one of our clubs you will need to complete a registration form, this can be collected from our office at Barton Seagrave and returned to any member of our team.

Children must be booked onto a session in advance, please do not drop your child off without checking they have a place first.

All fees are charged one month in advance and must be paid on the first of each month.

Don't forget we offer a 15% sibling discount!



## What we offer

We aim to provide an environment which provides a smooth and enjoyable transition to school in the morning, with a healthy breakfast and relaxed environment. After school we will provide plenty of opportunities for physical activity and outdoor play and having fun, but with the choice of quieter indoor activities too. We provide a wide range of activities, and aim to extend the opportunities that are available to children, including the introduction of forest school and bushcraft activities.
